FOUNDER'S AWARD NOMINATION FORM

The Founder's Award is a recognition for long term exemplary service to the lodge. Introduced at the 1981 National Order of the Arrow Conference, the Founder's Award is reserved for an Arrowman who demonstrates to fellow Arrowmen that he or she memorializes in his or her everyday life the spirit of achievement as described by founder E. Urner Goodman and co-founder Carroll A. Edson. Lodges must petition the National Order of the Arrow Committee to present an individual the Founder's Award. Shenandoah Lodge 258 may present a maximum of two Founder's Awards per year. If two Founder's Awards are presented, one of them must be to a youth.
