Order of the Arrow
Extended Elangomat Award



In close connection with the First Year Arrowman Award, the Extended Elangomat Award gives Elangomats a chance to exhibit their skills after the Ordeal, by staying in touch with their crew and seeing to it that certain requirements are met by their crew members. After the completion of the following requirements the Elangomat will receive the black Order of the Arrow sash, representing their Honor level at the time of completion.

THESE REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET BY THE SECOND WINTER BANQUET AFTER THE ORDEAL

1) Keep in touch with your crew members by contacting them by phone or email. Contact each of your crew members at least three times, and record it in the following table, noting the dates that you contacted each crew member.

Arrowmen in your crew must complete the following three requirements (the percentages regard the minimum percent of your crew that must complete the requirement.) Complete the table below each requirement, noting each crew member's name and the date of completion.

2) Attend at least **three** Lodge events other than their Ordeal. Lodge Retreat, One Day of Service, Winter Banquet, Spring Fellowship, June Inductions and August Inductions count for this requirement (specifying dates of completion is not mandatory for this requirement.) **(40%)**

4) Participate actively in their Unit (80%)

Crew members must complete two of the following (60%)

- 1) Serve as an Elangomat.
- 2) Attend the Section E-9 Conclave.
- 3) Help conduct an OA Unit Election*
- 4) Participate in a Camping Promotion presentation.*
- *5 & 6 can be done together; completed at units other than your own
- 5) Work Camp Staff and be involved with the OA Everyday Program.
- 6) Be an Order of the Arrow Unit Rep, Troop Rep Adviser, or the Leader of a Unit with an active Unit Rep program for at least four months.
- 7) Earn the First Year Arrowman Award.
- 8) Become a Lodge Ceremonialist, Drummer or Adviser.
- 9) Serve as the Chair or Adviser of a Lodge Committee.
- 10) Serve as an elected Lodge Officer or Adviser
